The Issuer announced today that certain amendments had been made to the Administration Agreement and the Replacement Cash Management Agreement as a result of a remediation exercise that is being carried out by The Co-operative Bank in connection to certain mortgages originated by The Co-operative Bank or other entities in The Co-operative Bank group, following the identification of certain conduct issues in relation to such mortgages. As a result, and following discussions with the Financial Conduct Authority, The Co-operative Bank is making an adjustment to the principal balances of the affected mortgages. Certain mortgages that are included in the Leek Finance Number Seventeen PLC Portfolio have been affected by these conduct issues and will have their principal balances reduced as a result of the remediation exercise. In order to reflect these reductions in the transaction entered into by the Issuer, the relevant transaction parties have entered into an amended and restated Administration Agreement and an amended and restated Replacement Cash Management Agreement to facilitate (i) the permanent write-down by the Principal Administrator of the principal balance of the affected mortgages in the Portfolio and (ii) a corresponding payment by The Co-operative Bank to the Issuer.

Capitalised terms used in this announcement have the meanings ascribed to them in the Administration Agreement and the Master Framework Agreement.
