The Co-operative Bank prides itself in being an ethical bank, and as such our customers rightly expect us to conduct our business with honesty and transparency. This expectation extends to our relationships with public institutions and individuals of political importance. As a business, we are strictly politically neutral and have commitments in place to ensure that we uphold our neutrality.

Our commitments

Our commitments in relation to political involvement, as outlined in our customer-led ethical policy, as follows:

- We will adopt the principles of best practice in our relationships with public institutions, as set out in the Association of Professional Political Consultants (APPC) Code of Conduct or equivalent bodies over time.
- We will publish details on a quarterly basis of all formal meetings on behalf of The Co-operative Bank between parliamentarians and members of The Bank's Board and Executive
- We will never donate to a political party, politician or party political campaign group
- We are committed to ensuring that The Co-operative Bank does nothing in its tax affairs that runs contrary to either the letter or spirit of UK tax legislation. As evidence of this, we are signatories to the Code of Practice for the Taxation of Banks.
